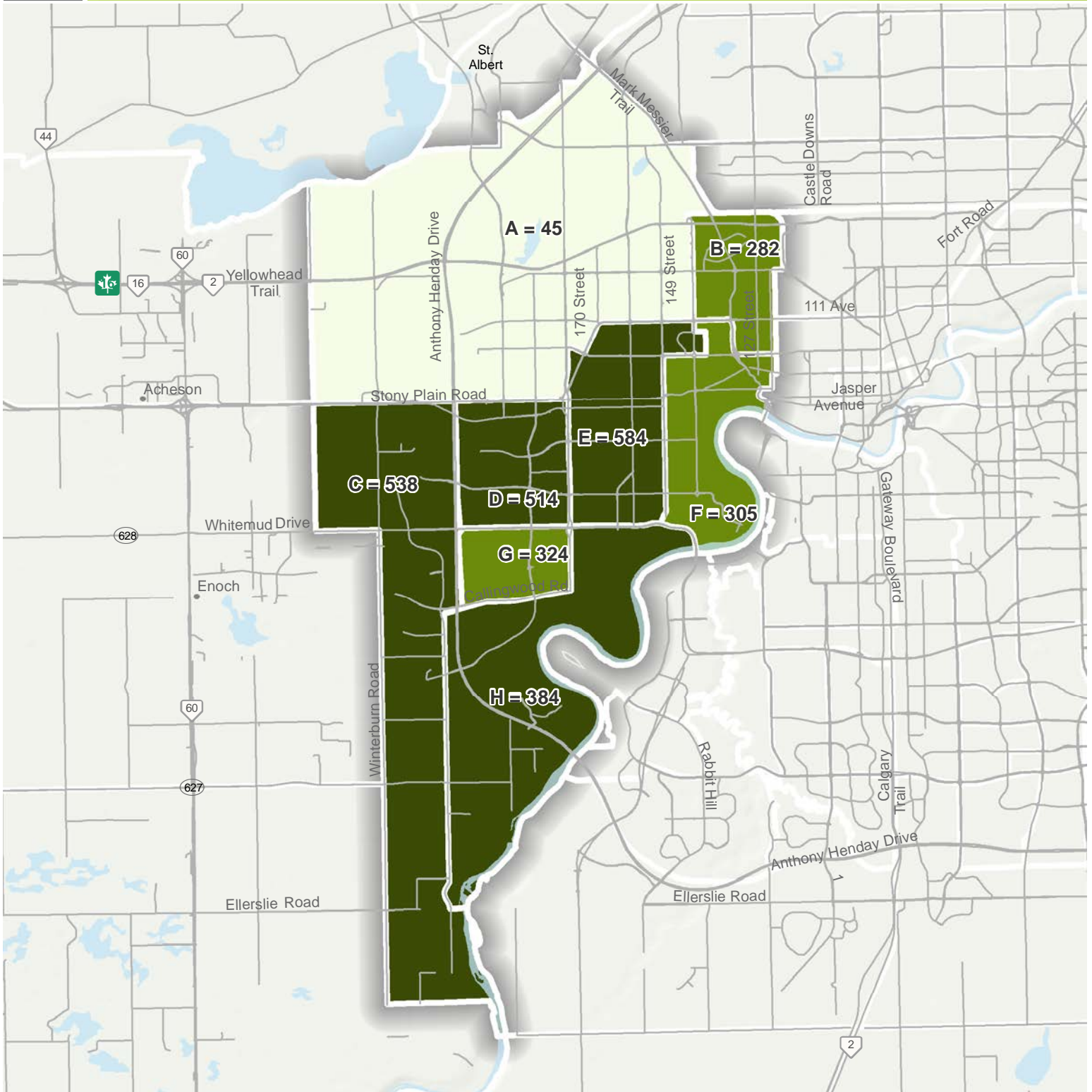

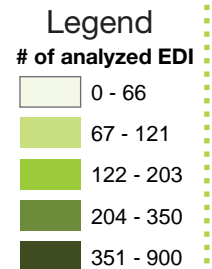
Edmonton West Community Overview

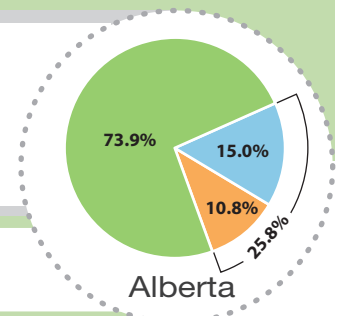
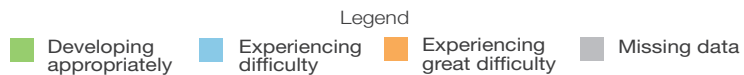


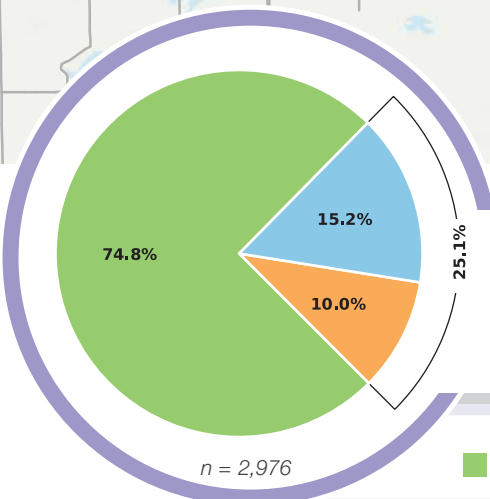
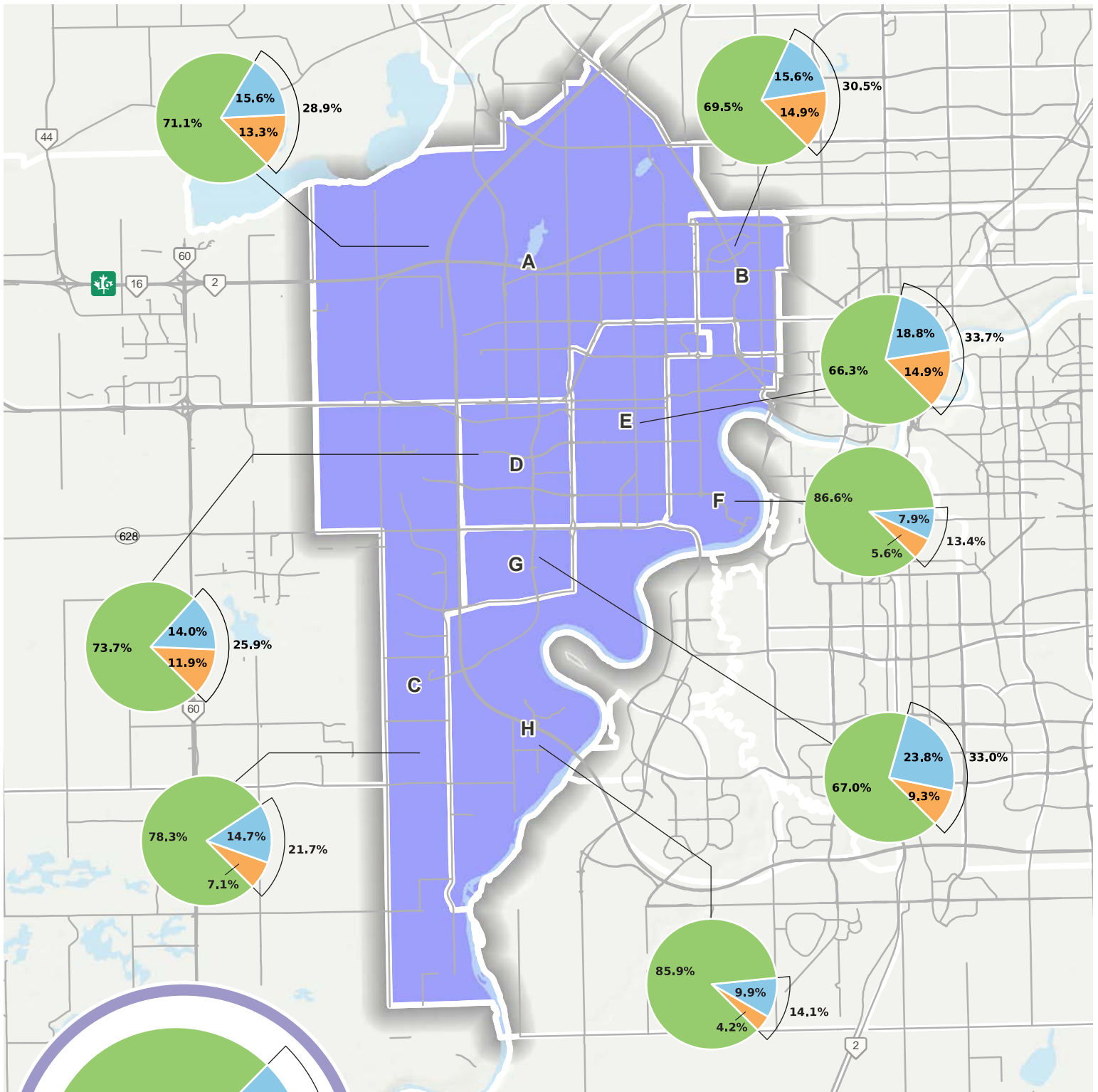
Edmonton West EDI - Emotional Maturity

Experiencing great difficulty (EGD) in one or more and two or more areas of development

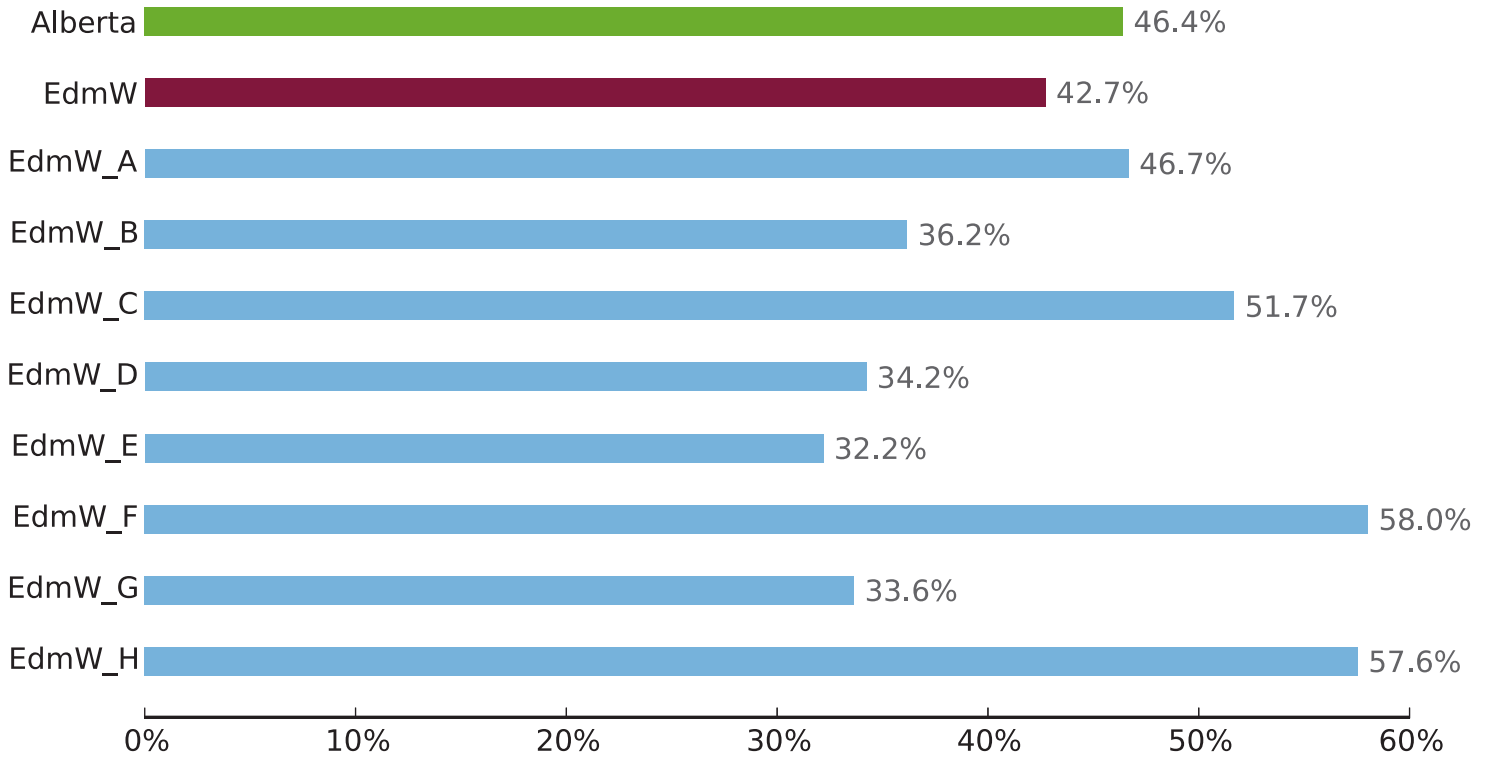


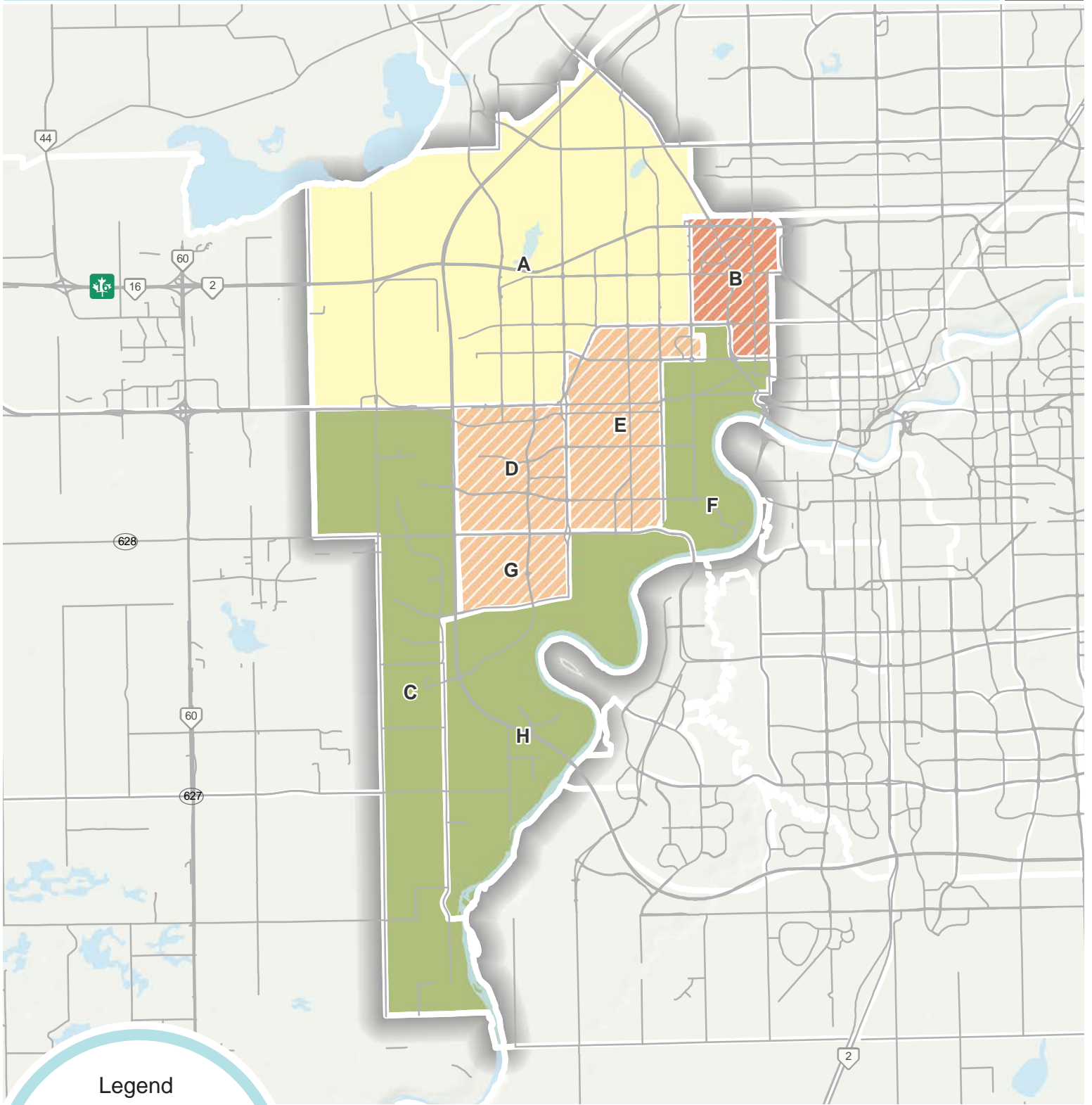

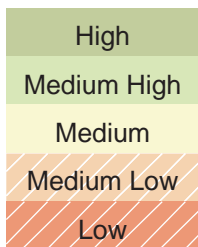
