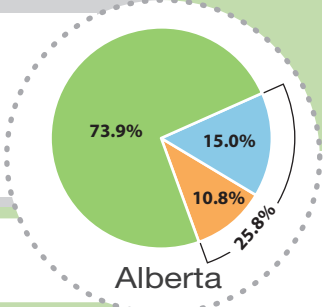


Fort Saskatchewan EDI - Emotional Maturity



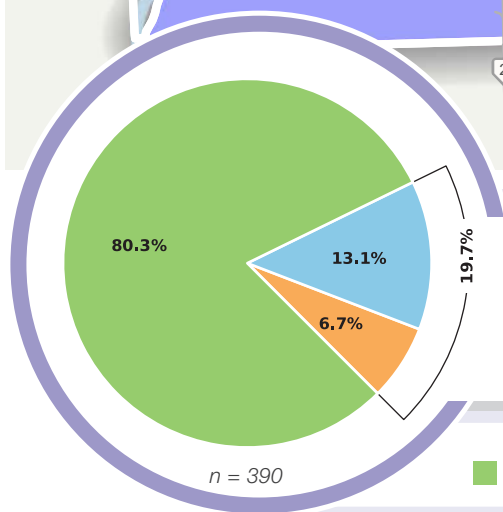
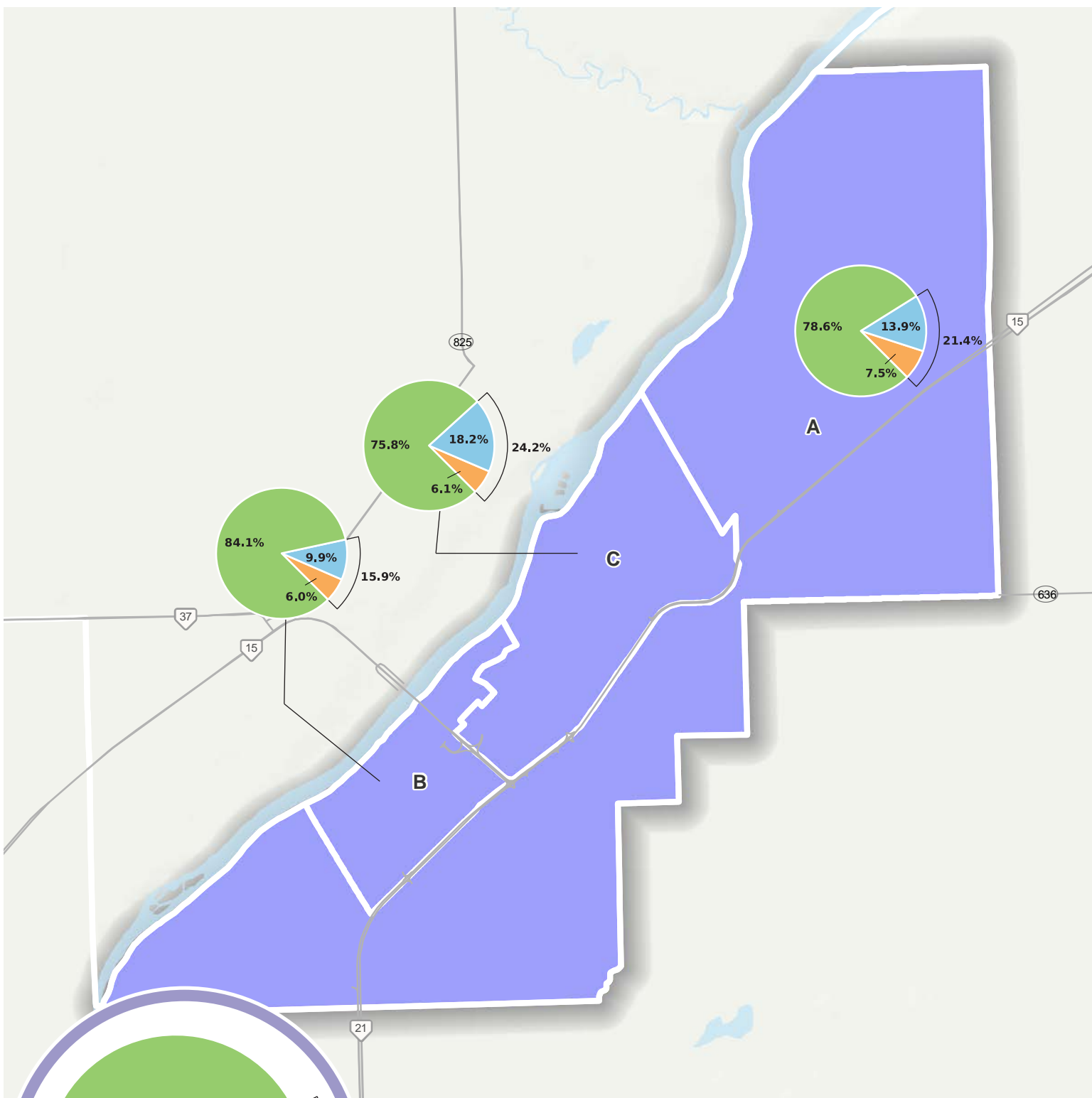
