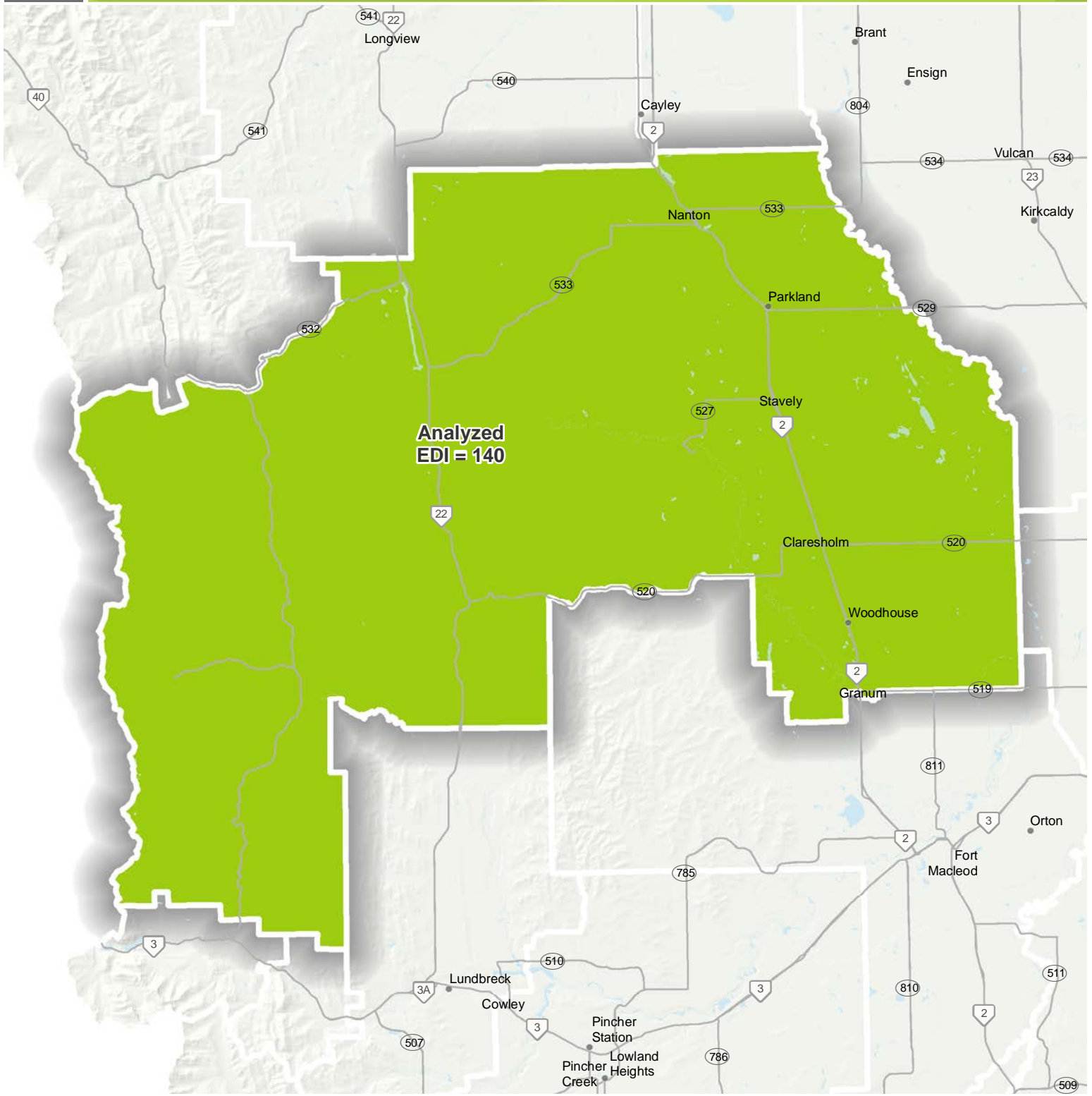

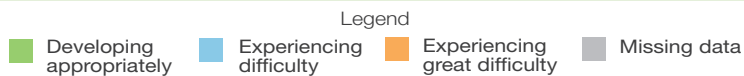
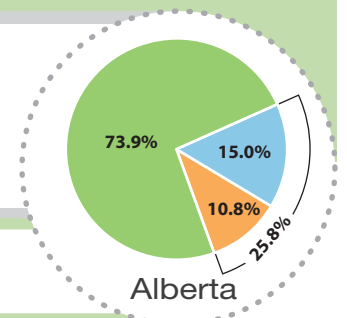


Porcupine Hills - Willow Creek EDI - Emotional Maturity



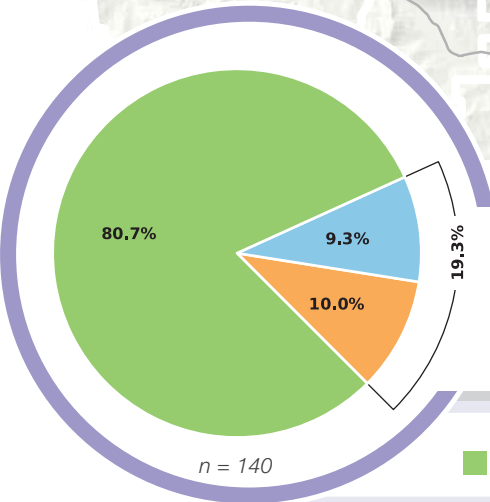
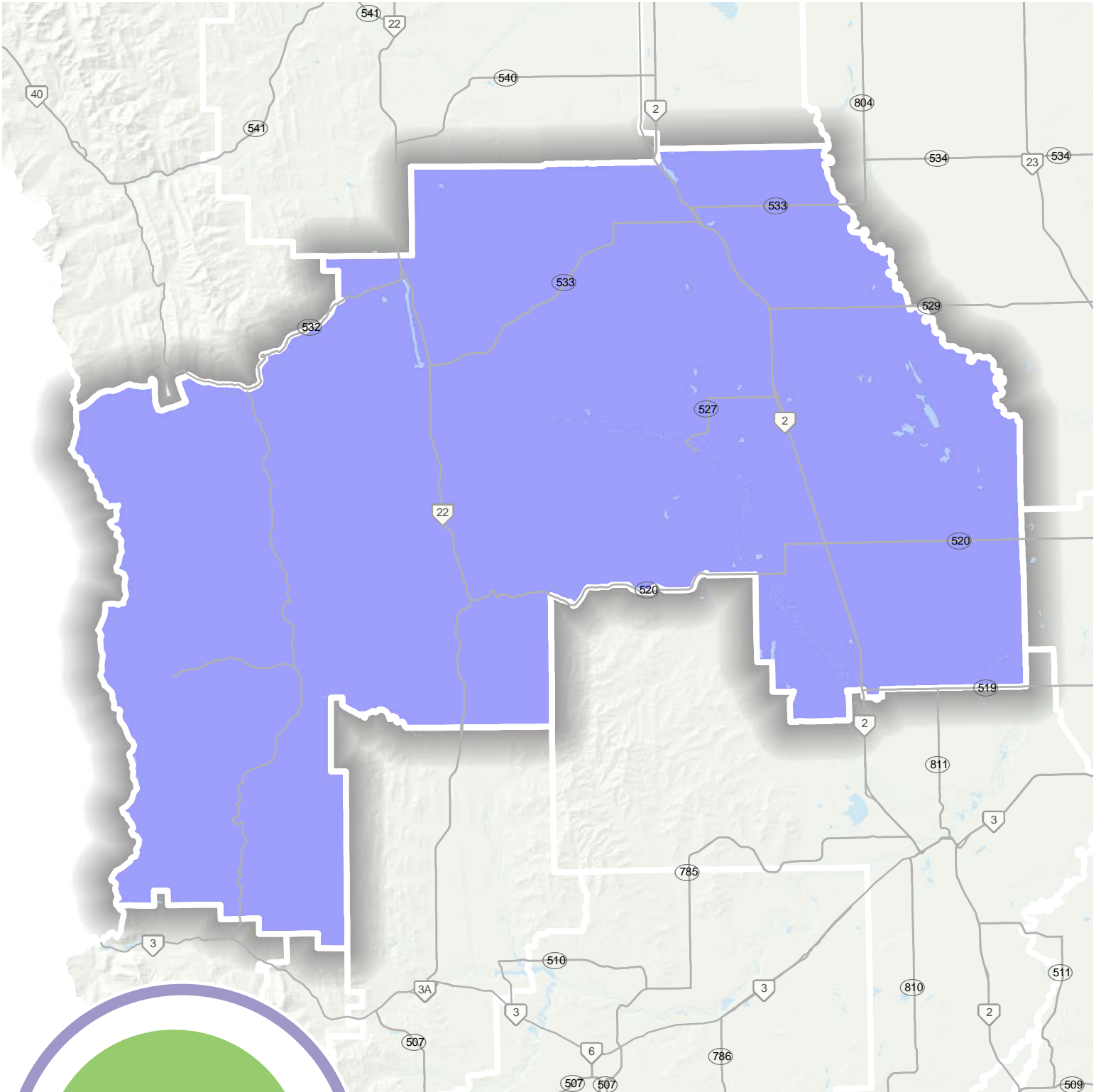
