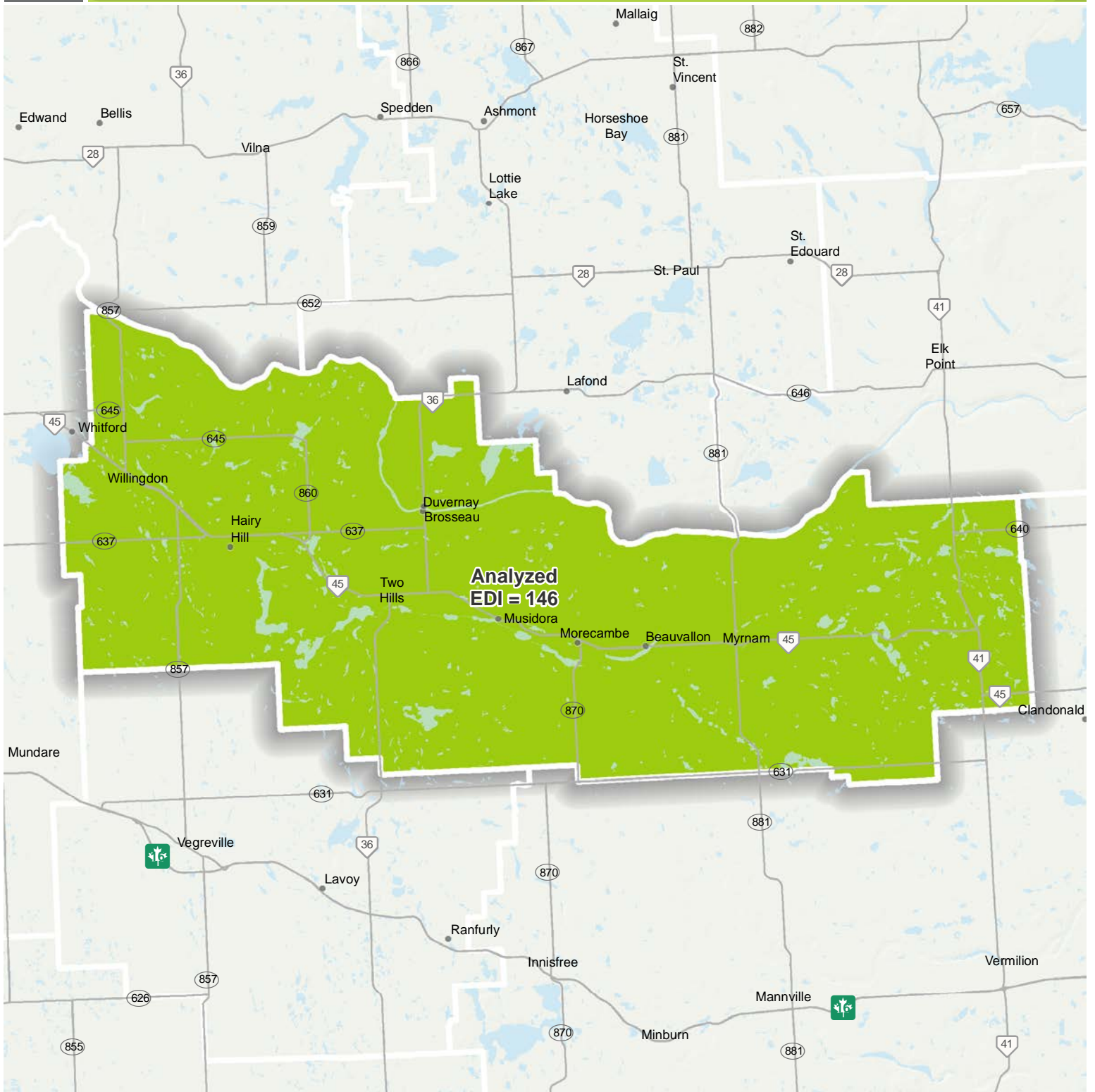

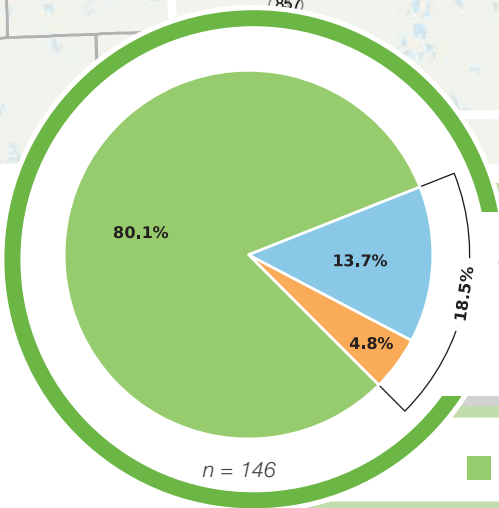
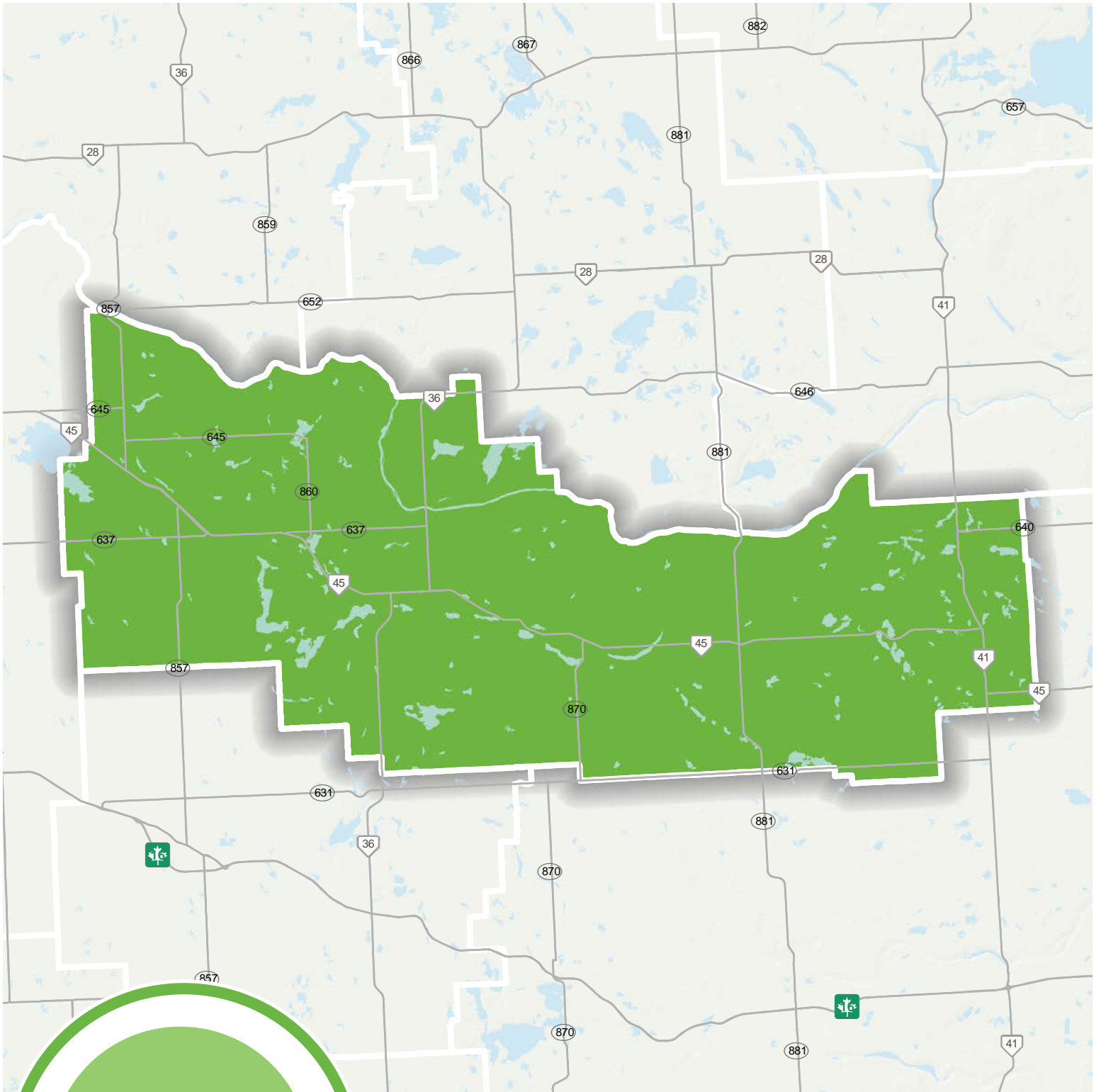


Two Hills County (TwoHill) Community Social Competence

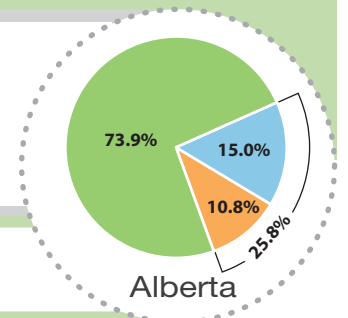
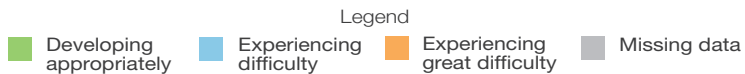


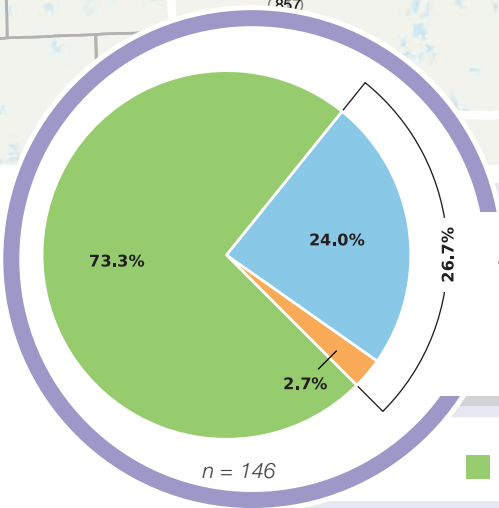
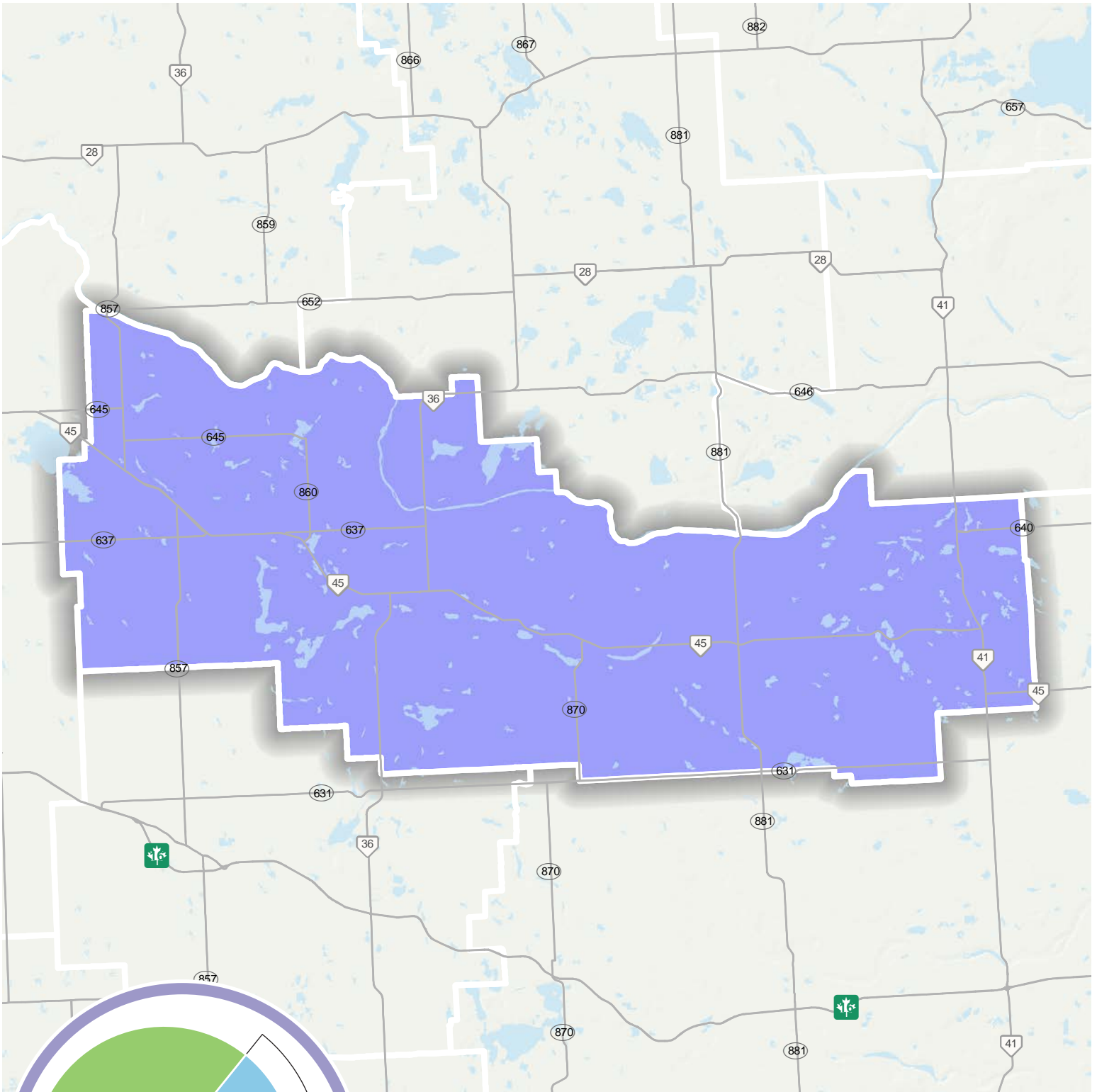
Two Hills County EDI - Emotional Maturity

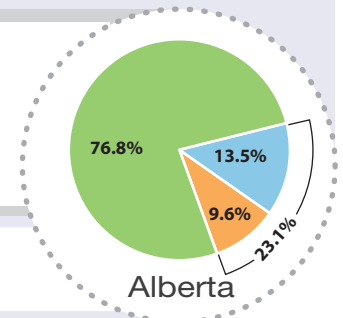




Two Hills County (TwoHill) Community Language and Thinking Skills

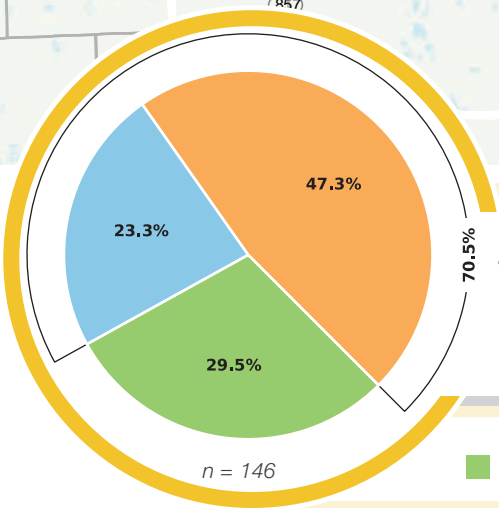
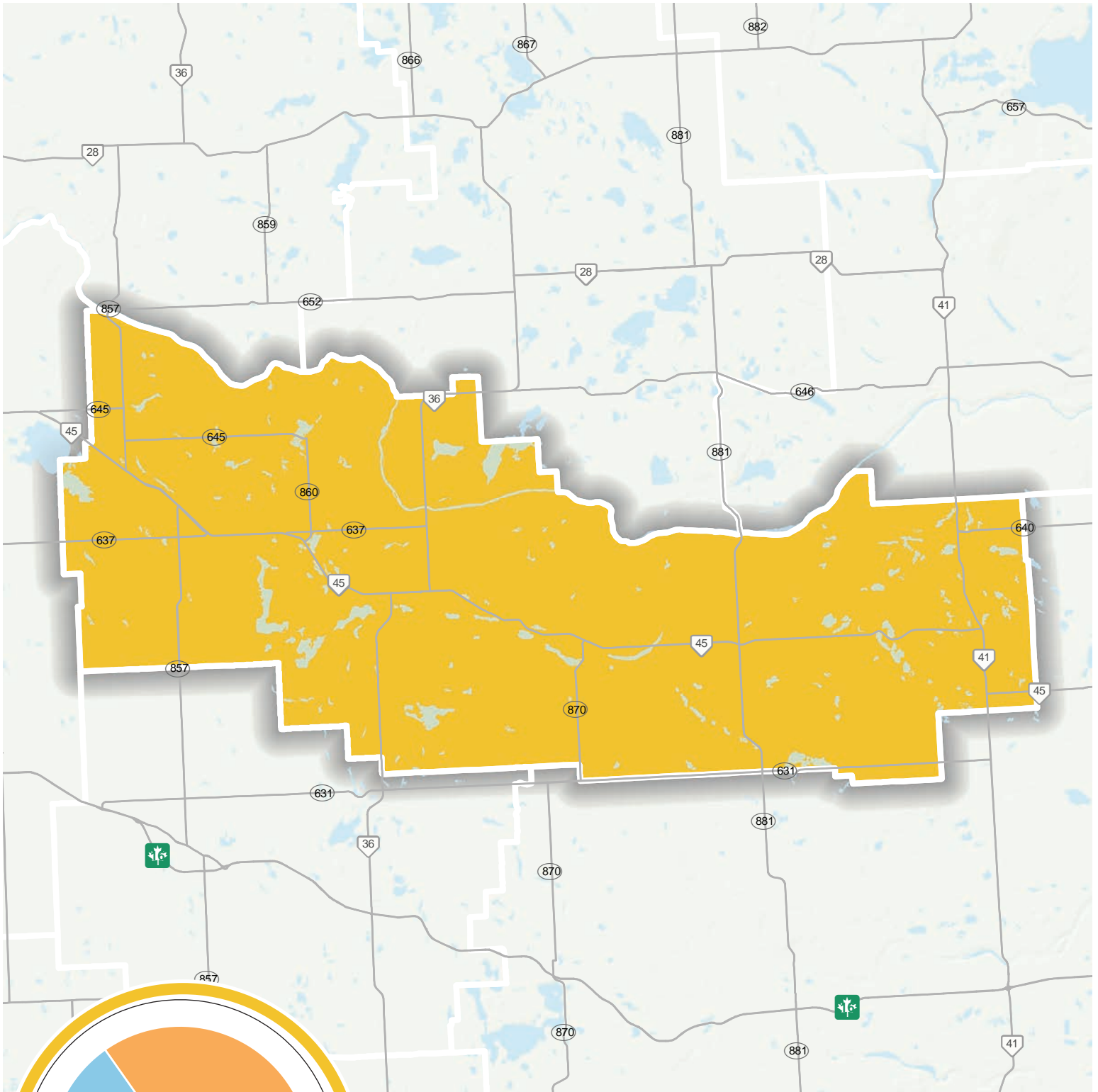

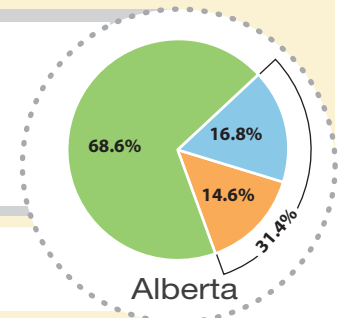

Experiencing great difficulty (EGD) in one or more and two or more areas of development

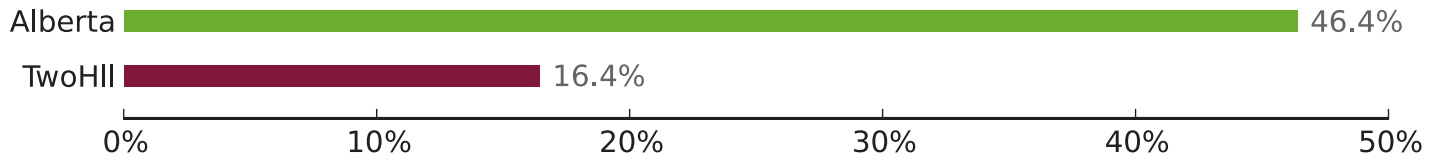

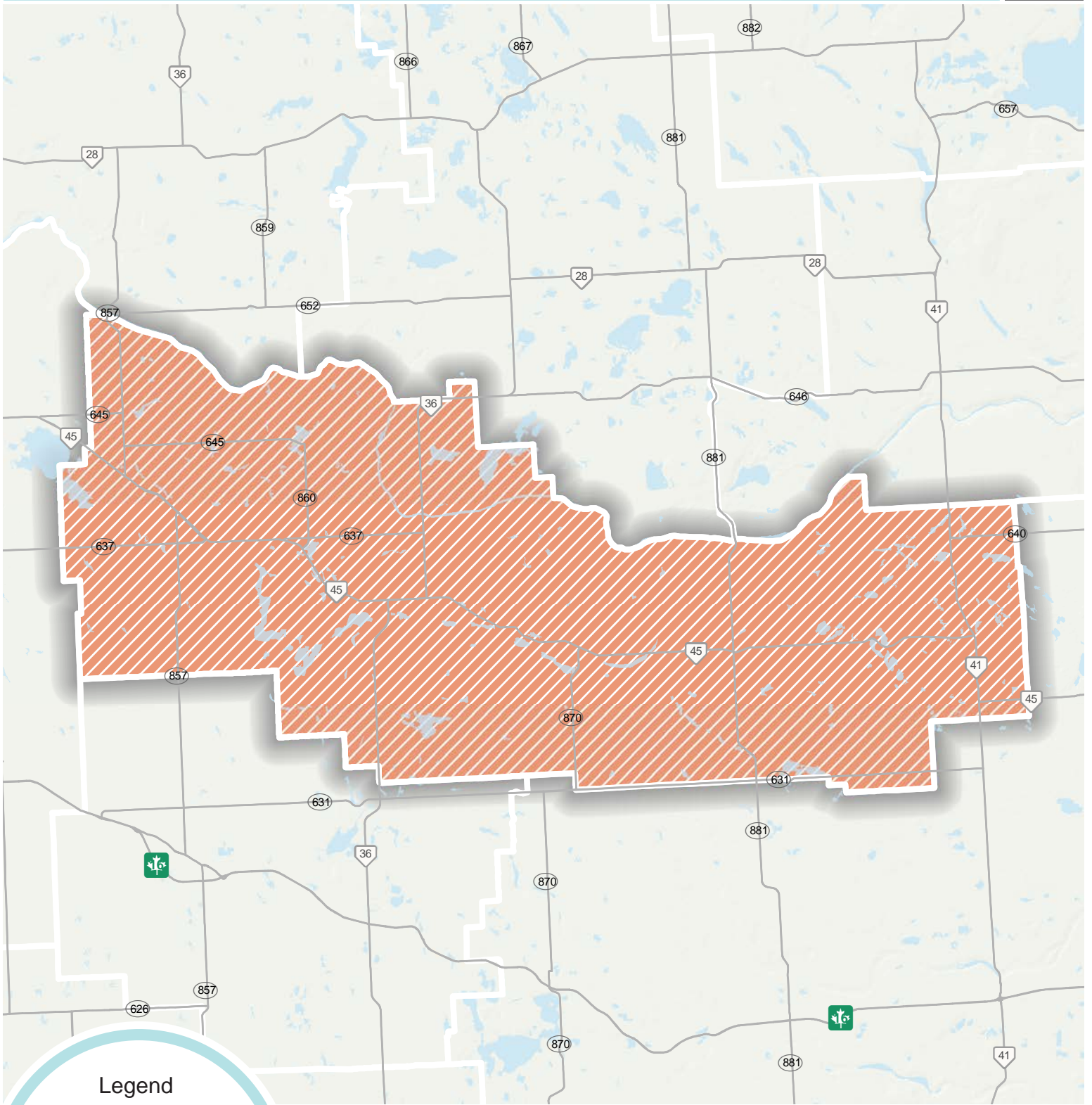

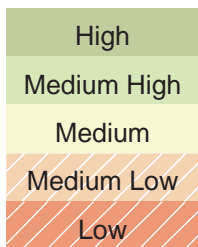


Two Hills County Socio-economic Status
