## Experiencing great difficulty (EGD) in one or more and two or more areas of development

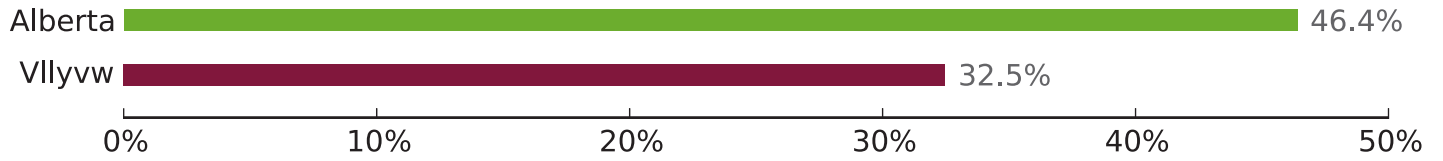

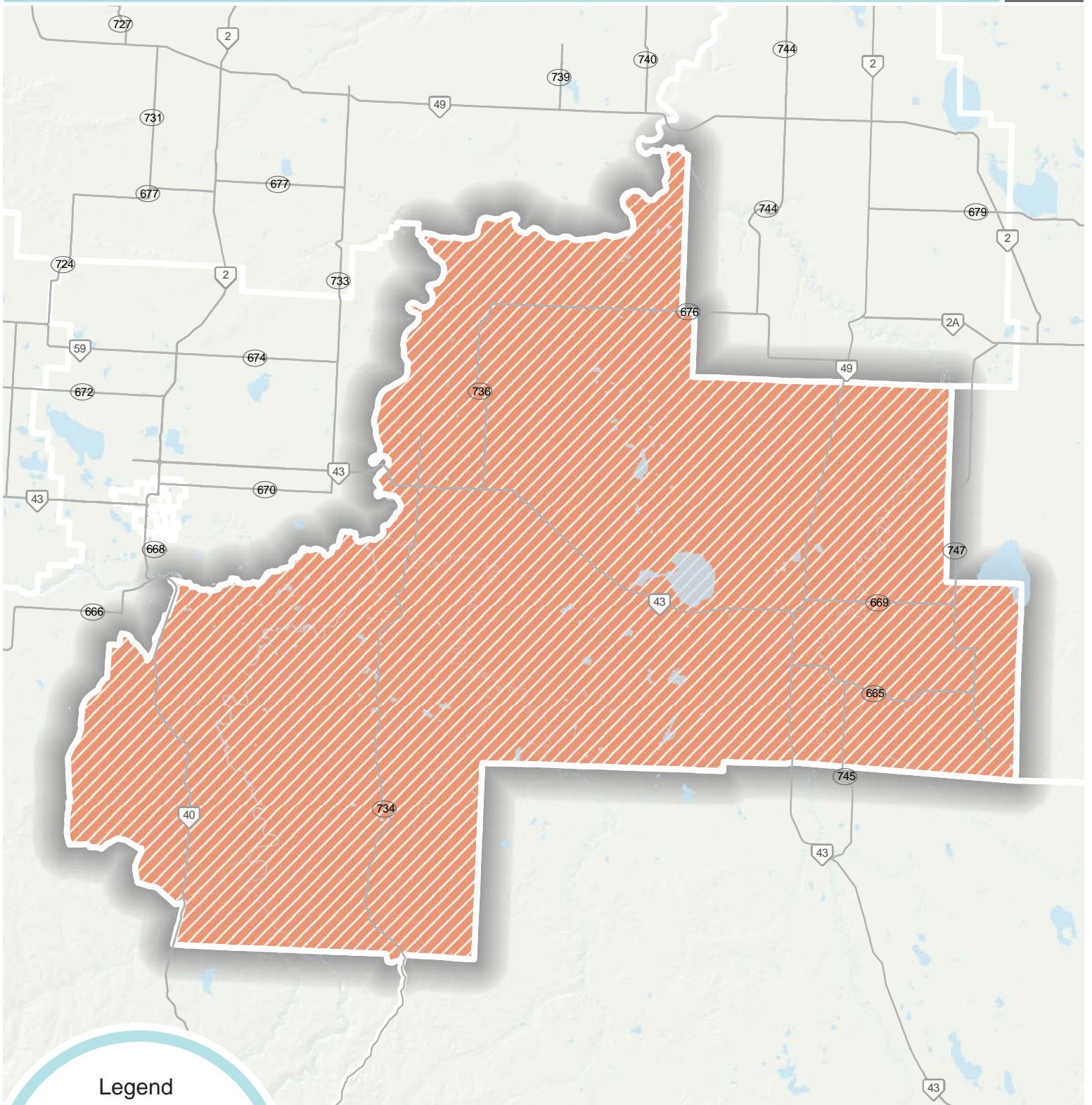

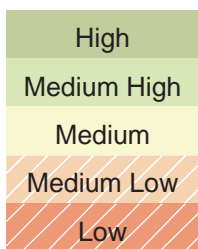
