

As a large urban area, Edmonton encompasses several early childhood development (ECD) communities. Information on Edmonton's seven communities has been compiled here for quick reference and comparison.








Five areas of development: Edmonton 2009-2013 results

The pie charts show how children are developing in each of the five areas of development.
















